Home	Classroom
<p>Personalization – From the Schola class schedule, parents choose the course of study that is best for their student, including advanced courses that the parent does not feel equipped to teach. Our Academic Advisor is available to help parents make an educational plan that is appropriate for each child.</p> <p>Flexibility – Each family can uniquely structure at-home study days to carefully manage family time, outside activities, and homework.</p> <p>Family – Parents are ultimately responsible for the education of their children and continue to act as a primary mentor during the early, critical years of a child’s education and spiritual formation. Parents fulfill this role as they facilitate learning on the days students are at home.</p>	<p>Structure – Teachers provide subject expertise and resources in concentrated class instruction once or twice per week. Teachers also provide weekly assignments so that students and parents know exactly what work should be completed at home before the next class meeting.</p> <p>Accountability – Teachers provide instruction and set expectations for student learning at home. Teachers evaluate progress by means of quizzes, tests, and writing assignments and provide consistent feedback to students and parents regarding progress in each class.</p> <p>Community – Students learn, grow, and socialize in a community of faith that nourishes the whole child. Special “Schola Life” events include picnics for Schola families, Coffee Chats for parents, as well as planned social interactions both on and off campus for students.</p>

Students will develop skills of listening, observation, and narration in a gentle atmosphere that "tills the soil" of young minds and hearts. They will explore great music and art while developing their own skills in these areas. They will also be introduced to key events and people in world history, learn basic geography concepts, and take a big picture look at the Old and New Testaments.</p> <p>The campus teacher provides weekly lesson guides to assist parents with home assignments which reinforce classroom instruction.</p>

Students will explore great music and art while developing their own skills in these areas. They will also be introduced to key people and events in biblical and world history and continue their study of geography.</p> <p>The campus teacher provides weekly lesson guides to assist parents with home assignments which reinforce classroom instruction. Students may register for a complete program or individual classes as needed.

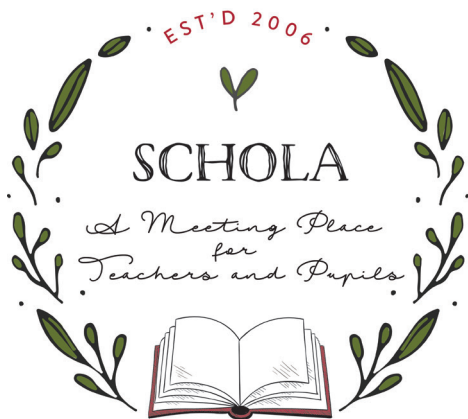

*The heart of the Schola High School Program is the interdisciplinary humanities class **The Great Conversation**. TGC introduces students to conflicts in world views that have occurred over the past 3000 years, thus joining in "the great conversation" of men and women through the ages about the perennial issues of human life. Because ideas have consequences, students will study the philosophy and theology of western culture in order to understand the expression of its world view in literature, art, music, government, economics, and science.
